Dear Parents/Carers,

At the start of the week, during our whole school assembly, I spoke to the children about what might happen if a child's family's rules differ from another family's rules - maybe one child is not allowed to watch a TV programme or play a computer game that other children are allowed to watch or play? I was so impressed by the responses from this. I had wondered if the negative things that might happen would be the first to be mentioned, which would then lead into a conversation about **resilience** and kindness, however, I was very pleasantly surprised by our first response—**"Instead of talking about the programme or game that the other child can't play or watch, I would talk about different things in front of them, so that they can join in."** I loved this and explained that although we do need to show resilience when other people are unfair and unkind, the best solution is to show **respect** for each other and each other's families at all times. Our children increasingly understand this message—**In a world where you can be anything, be kind!** - as a Highcliffe pupil or member of staff, we know that it is our **responsibility** to make everybody feel like a somebody, through our actions and words. You will have seen the resilience calendars sent home—I hope the children will find them useful, not just for this month, but whenever they might need a reminder or a solution to a problem. I will look forward to seeing some of the suggestions in action over the next few weeks!
