Dear Parents/Carers,

We have spoken a lot this week about one of our values, **Responsibility**. I have been so impressed by the children's understanding of quite a tricky concept. Two ideas have stood out—**WRONG IS WRONG even if everyone is doing it; RIGHT IS RIGHT even if no one is doing it** and **You are always responsible for how you act, no matter how you feel**. I feel hugely confident that our ongoing discussions around these ideas, as well as the intensive support we offer to children who do find it difficult to control their emotions, will continue to make a massive difference to all of our children. I will be sharing this quote next week—**Children need to learn to take responsibility for their actions, so that they do not become adults believing that nothing is ever their fault**. I feel incredibly strongly that this is what we must instil, and I take my **responsibility** ensuring this extremely seriously. **Thank you for your support of the decisions we make regarding sanctions and consequences**— it is crucial to have this if we are to achieve our goal, where everybody can take full responsibility for their actions, and accept the consequences. I have been delighted with the number of children who are demonstrating that they can do this already!

**Sports for Schools—Jenny Wallwork** You will have received your child's sponsorship form for this event, with a run down of what will be happening on Monday 25th June, as part of the Sports for Schools initiative. We had an assembly last week where we showed the children how they will be taking part, and learned about the GB Badminton player, Jenny Wallwork. 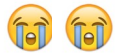
Then we were hungry and we ate lunch. We played after we ate. After we went on a bridge then we saw a dead body and we saw a locomotive out of meccano.
