We cannot thank you enough for being there for Alfie until his Mum got there and then speaking with the police and paramedics to explain what happened. So that we can ensure children are safe on the roads on their route home from school, we will be continuing to discuss road safety in school. We are explaining how important it is to wear a helmet—thank you for your support with enforcing this.
