Dear Parents/Carers,

We are of course always against any type of bullying, every day of every week, but it has been so useful to spend more time than usual speaking about this issue during **Anti-bullying Week**. We are incredibly proud of our children for ensuring that we have very few problems with bullies at Highcliffe. We keep sharing that each one of them has the right to feel safe and happy coming to school and that, if this is not the case, we will help them. We also remind them constantly that anybody displaying unkind behaviour does not actually have power over anybody else—even if it feels like they have—those trying to make others unhappy are not happy themselves. We will always support our children to choose kindness, and to speak out if they ever experience anything other than that.

Potential COVID Symptom Procedures—Huge thanks again to you all for supporting the procedures we have in place at the moment, for dealing with potential COVID symptoms. We understand fully how frustrating it must be when we have to send home your child, and therefore any siblings—especially if you feel the symptoms are due to an annual cough, asthma or a cold. We also know that the wider implications for other family members having to isolate as a result are really difficult to manage, but, unfortunately, we are not able to make any exceptions.

We have been instructed by our local public health team to respond to a persistent, new cough, high temperature or lost of taste/smell as though there is a positive case, until we know for certain otherwise. They have asked us to do this as they know children can have a cold and COVID. Similarly with infections like tonsillitis that might cause a fever—because we know that it is possible to have both at the same time, we must ask everybody with any of the three official symptoms to isolate/get a test (fortunately, results are coming back much more quickly now). Our risk assessments and protocols are available on our website and your support of these- and respectful response- is appreciated so much.
