In response to the parents and children who have expressed concerned that there is often not enough choice for classes on later sittings, we have made some changes. You should have received a menu today, with meal options for each day, that you can complete with your child. Main Entrance

Please note that our side gate is open until 9am and should be used by all children from Reception to Year 6 when they arrive at school. **Unless permission has been given, please do not use the main entrance to drop off your children before 9am.** If they arrive after this time, they will be given a late mark. **We carried out punctuality spot checks this week and will continue to do so to encourage everybody to arrive on time.** Learning starts immediately and too many of our children are missing out. **Please do everything you can to ensure your child is present and on time.
