Behaviour Policy

We are in the process of making the rewards and sanctions part of our behaviour policy much clearer for parents, children, staff and governors. There will be no change to the principles of the policy, where we use positive reinforcement to ensure that we are doing everything we can do provide a safe, nurturing environment for everybody. However, for the small minority of children who routinely lose all of their Golden Time each week, we will be outlining what happens next.

I am confident that involving parents earlier after repeated incidents, as well as our zero tolerance for violent or dangerous behaviour, bullying and refusing members of staff, will continue to improve behaviour at the school. Our newly agreed values (**Respect, Resilience and Responsibility**) will also assist massively with this.

On Mondays, children who have kept all of their Golden Time from the week will now be awarded a **Golden Sticker**. **This will guarantee special recognition and privileges!**
