Curriculum Information for Year 1 and 2

This term we will ...

Maths

Learn how to:

- Count forwards and backwards
- Compare amounts of objects and numbers
- Represent and compare numbers to 20
- Read, write and order numbers to 20
- Use ordinal numbers
- Find one more and one less
- Add and subtract numbers within 10
- Recognise and name 2-D and 3-D shapes

Science

Learn about changes by:

- Observing changes across the four seasons
- Describing weather associated with each season
- Observing how day length varies

Learn about plants including trees by:

- Identifying and naming common wild and garden plants
- Naming deciduous and evergreen trees
- Describing the basic structure of common flowering plants and trees

English

Listen to and read daily stories/poems to enhance our enjoyment of books.

Through Sounds-Write learn that:

- Letters are symbols (spellings) that represent sounds
- A sound may be spelled by 1, 2, 3 or 4 letters
- The same sound can be spelled in more than one way
- Many spellings can represent more than one sound
- We can blend sounds to read and segment words into sounds for spelling

Learn how to:

- Write simple sentences using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces

Learn how to:

- Write to inform and entertain, by writing about the seasons and descriptions

Computing

Learn about:

- Information technology around us by recognising technology in school and using it responsibly
- Digital painting by using tools in a program to create art

Learn about:

- Tag rugby by developing movement and ball handling skills
- Athletics by developing jumping and throwing skills

History

Learn about:

- Changes within living memory — how I have grown and changed
- What shops were like in the past
- What shops are like in the present
- How shops have changed

Art

Learn about:

- How marks can be made using a range of drawing tools
- The names of the primary colours and how paint can be used to make a range of marks

Geography

Learn about:

- The 7 continents of the world
- The 5 oceans of the world
- The 4 countries of the United Kingdom
- The capital cities of the United Kingdom
- The seas that surround the United Kingdom
