- Number: Addition and subtraction using 3 digit numbers and written methods

- **Find** (& revise 1 or 10) 100 more or less than a number

Learn:

- Double and halve numbers to 1,000

- \times and \div facts for 3, 4, and 8s using bar models, arrays and pattern spotting

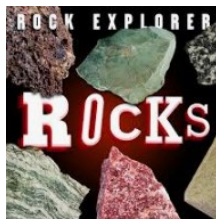
