In Communication and Language this term, we are learning how to:

- Demonstrate good listening and follow simple instructions.
- Express a point of view and share what we think.
- Take it in turns to speak.
- Apply the new vocabulary we have been taught.

- Take care of our own toilet needs and ask for help where needed.
