In maths this term, we are learning to:

- Partition numbers up to 1000
- Place numbers on a number line up to 1000
- Find 1, 10 or 100 more or less
- Compare numbers to 1000
- Find 1, 10, 100 and 1000 more or less than a number
- Order numbers to 1000
- Add and subtract 1s, 10s and 100s
- · Add 2 digit and 3 digit numbers
- Subtract a 2 digit number from a 3 digit number
- Recite x and ÷ facts for the 2, 3, 4 and 8 times tables

In English this term, we are learning how to:

- Write to inform

- Use present tense
- Use third person

- Use fronted adverbials
