In **maths** this term, we are learning to:

- Partition numbers up to 10 000.
- Place numbers on a number line up to 10 000
- Add and subtract 4 digit numbers using written methods
- Recite x and ÷ facts for 3,6,7,9,11 and 12 times tables
- Find 1, 10, 100 and 1000 more or less than a number
- Order numbers to 10 000
- Compare numbers up to 10 000
- Round to the nearest 10,100 and 1000
- Read Roman numerals up to 100
