Behaviour Stage	Sanction
Stage 1 -Low-level disruption* – talking, rocking/swinging on chairs, inattention, not following instructions, silly noises, excessive noise, distracting others; -Disrespectful comments to adults, e.g. complaining about having to complete work etc.; -Rough play – grabbing, holding, pulling to the ground; -'Wonderful Walking' breach; -Poor presentation in books*; -Incorrect PE kit/no PE kit*; -Playing with equipment when asked not to, including during PE; -Deliberate poor table manners; -Not lining up sensibly/as instructed; -Silly behaviour at inappropriate times; -Running in the halls at lunchtime; -Playing in prohibited areas – bushes, area outside the Rainbow Room, against the fences or railings and outside the Y2 doors.	Verbal Warning Marked on class list
Stage 2 -Repeat of Stage 1 behaviour; -Dishonesty about own behaviour; -Deliberate disruption – screaming or screeching, walking around the classroom/hall without permission; -Defacing school property; -Spitting around others; -Not handing in phone/bringing in phone without parent letter; -Chewing/eating in class or when it's not playtime/lunch time, without permission; -Bringing in sweets/chocolate/chewing gum etc.; -Bringing in toys/items from home, without permission; -Entering store cupboards, offices or areas around school (out of own phase) without permission; -Swearing; -Rough play leading to injury. Stage 3 -Repeated Stage 2 behaviour; -Dishonesty about somebody else; -Leaving an area without permission;	Written Warning Letter sent to parents that includes behaviour stage

- -Name calling/teasing/mimicking/making fun of others:
- -Aggressive behaviour pushing, squaring up, threats;

- -Vandalism/graffiti.

- -Swearing at adults;
- -Significant deliberate damage to school property;
- -Theft.
