Safeguarding at Highcliffe: Social Media

As we have shared with you often, we talk to the children about safe, appropriate online use on a regular basis, and, when asked, they can tell us what they should do in order to ensure this. Unfortunately, we know that a growing number of them are not always putting this knowledge into practice.

In a recent assembly, children as young as Y3 said they had Snapchat, Instagram and/or WhatsApp on their phones or other devices.

I have reminded them all that the respective age limit for these apps are 13 and 16 and that there is a very important reason for this.

Many of the children using them this young run the risk of becoming involved in group chats with older children (some unknown to them) and being exposed to content that is simply not appropriate. It is also difficult for all primary aged children to grasp the consequences of having arguments or being unkind via social media, which can create huge upset for those on the receiving end of abuse, especially when they can't escape it. We would really appreciate your support with reinforcing how to stay safe and show kindness online, so that time engaging with each other in this way is enjoyable and appropriate, and will not lead to children regretting anything they have written or said online that can be retrieved. Safer Internet Day (6th February) resources will follow soon. Thank you.
