Safeguarding at Highcliffe:

As you will know, we marked RSE Day yesterday, with every class learning about the NSPCC PANTS rules, and Y5 and Y6 learning about puberty and sex education respectively.

We were so proud of the children's responses right across school and feel confident they understand more fully that their bodies belong to them, and that they would know what to do if they were ever made to feel uncomfortable.

These sessions teach the children about consent at an age appropriate level, and strengthen their understanding of safe and un-safe touch. Empowering them in this way is a responsibility we take very seriously, to keep everybody as safe as possible.

Our older children were incredibly resilient during their RSE sessions, and we hope they feel better equipped to deal with the changes ahead that they will experience.
