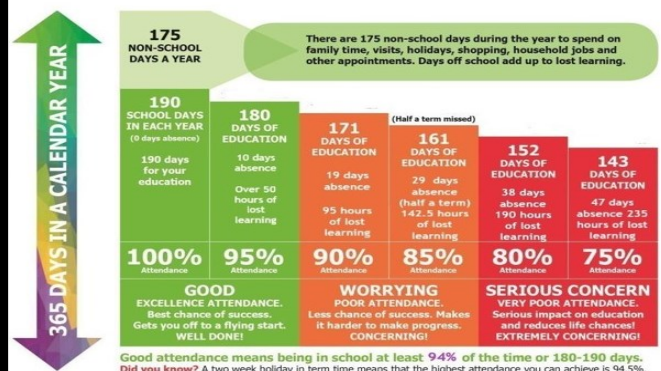
We beat our target! We're so pleased with our improved attendance, and the reduction in the number of lates this week—let's keep it up everyone! Thank you.
