Safeguarding at Highcliffe:

Antibullying— our assemblies this week have focussed on how we will continue to stamp out any bullying at Highcliffe.

It is extremely rare here, fortunately, and we are determined to ensure that every single child understands the following:

You can be cross, but never cruel;

It is never okay to comment negatively on Physical appearance, Protected Characteristics (including race, religion, gender, age, sexuality etc.) or Family Dynamics;

You don't have to be friends with everyone, but kindness is always required;

Stop means stop. No means no.

We shared a copy of our anti-bullying policy with the children and discussed the definition of bullying; how to recognise if it is happening and what to do if we experience it or see it happening. Every child was given a paper copy to take home and refer to, and we have been so impressed by their understanding of how we can all work together to ensure Highcliffe remains a safe environment where kind, respectful behaviour is always the expectation for everyone.
