Highcliffe Primary Curriculum Information Year 1 Autumn 2025

In **maths** this term, we are learning to:

- Represent and compare numbers to 20
- Read, write and order numbers to 20
- Use ordinal numbers
- Find one more and one less
- Add and subtract numbers within 10
- Recognise and name 2-D and 3-D shapes
- Use rekenreks to understand composition of numbers and to develop subitising skills

In **science** this term, we are:

Learning about changes by:

- Observing changes across the four seasons
- Describing weather associated with each season
- Observing how day length varies

Learning about plants including trees by:

- Identifying and naming common wild and garden plants
- Naming deciduous and evergreen trees
- Describing the basic structure of common flowering plants and trees

In **English** this term, we are learning how to:

Listen to and read daily stories/poems to enhance our enjoyment of books.

Through Sounds-Write learn that:

- Letters are symbols (spellings) that represent sounds
- A sound may be spelled by 1, 2, 3 or 4 letters
- Many spellings can represent more than one sound
- We can blend sounds to read and segment words into sounds for spelling

Learn how to:

- Write simple sentences using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces

Learn how to:

- Write to inform by writing about the seasons, recounts and letters

In **computing** this term, we are learning how to:

- Use information technology around us by recognising technology in school and using it responsibly
- Create a digital painting using a range of tools in a specific programme.

Please read each night and return books on Monday and Thursday

Please practise number bonds to 10 and counting forwards and backwards to 50.

In PE this term, we are learning about:

- Tag rugby by developing movement and ball handling skills
- Athletics by developing jumping and throwing skills

Our PE days are Wednesday and Thursday.

Please come in PE kit on these days.

In history this term, we are learning about:

- Changes within living memory — how I have grown and changed
- What shops were like in the past
- What shops are like in the present
- How shops have changed

In art this term, we are learning about:

- How marks can be made using a range of drawing tools
- The names of the primary colours and how paint can be used to make a range of marks

In geography this term, we are learning about:

- The 7 continents of the world
- The 5 oceans of the world
- The 4 countries of the United Kingdom
- The capital cities of the United Kingdom
- The seas that surround the United Kingdom

In music this term, we are learning about:

- Action songs
- Recognising and keeping a beat
- Simple rhymes in time

In Design and Technology this term, we are learning:

- How sliders work
- How to design and make a card slider product
- About different structures and investigating why they do not fall over

In RE this term, we are learning about:

- Who I am and why I am special
- How and why Christians celebrate harvest
- What it means to belong in Christianity
- Why we give gifts at Christmas

In PSHE this term, we are learning about:

- Wellbeing and emotional regulation practices
- How to stay safe online
- Families and people who care for me
