# Highcliffe Primary Curriculum Information Year 3 Spring 2026

## In **maths** this term, we are learning to:

- Multiply a 2 digit number by 1 digit number
- Link multiplication and division
- Divide a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number
- Measure in metres, centimetres and millimetres
- Compare, add and subtract lengths
- Measure and calculate perimeter
- Compare and order fractions
- Count in fractions
- Find equivalent
- Measure mass in grams and kilograms
- Measure capacity and volume in millilitres and litres

## In **English** this term, we are learning how to:

- Write to entertain
- Write descriptions
- Accurately form and use well-structured sentences
- Use a range of sentences
- Use Sounds-Write for spelling accuracy
- Use cursive handwriting
- Use expanded noun phrases
- Use fronted adverbials
